Roll Call

Mayor Buckley opened the meeting and City Clerk Kathy Marlock commenced with the roll call. All Board members were present.

Approval of Minutes

Mayor Buckley introduced the minutes from the August 22, 2017 board work session and opened the floor for discussion. There being no discussion, Alderman Travaglini made a motion to approve the minutes. Alderman Scherer seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

Bills

Mayor Buckley introduced the bills submitted for payment, quickly reviewed each, and asked if there was any discussion. There being no discussion, Alderman Travaglini made a motion to approve the bills submitted for payment. Alderman Kauffmann seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Resolution: Oppose Statewide Vote for Restructuring Government in St. Louis City and County

The Mayor introduced the discussion of the resolution encouraging opposition to statewide vote on the restructuring of local government in St. Louis City and St. Louis County. The Mayor then called for a motion to accept the resolution. Alderman Travaglini made the motion, seconded by Alderman Scherer and it passed unanimously.

Sign Permit Application #186-17: 7391 Watson Road, Dale Sign Company, SSM Health

The Mayor introduced all Sign Permit Applications noting the Building Commissioner indicated each met City Code. Chris at Dale Signs attended the session. The Mayor called for discussion. There being no discussion the Mayor requested a motion for approval. Alderman Kauffmann made the motion for approval, seconded by Alderman Travaglini. The motion passed unanimously.

Sign Permit Application #210-17: 4118 Shrewsbury, Warren Sign Company, Spire Energy

The Mayor called for discussion. There being no discussion the Mayor requested a motion for approval. Sign Permit Application #211-17: 7722 Big Bend Blvd., SWT Design

Jim Walterman representing SWT Design attended the session. The Mayor applauded the work of SWT Design in the Shrewsbury Community and their positive use of space in the Big Bend Corridor. She then reminded the Board that the Sign Permit Application had previously been noted as meeting City Code. She called for a discussion. There being no discussion the Mayor requested a motion for approval. Alderman Scherer made the motion for approval, seconded by Alderwoman Gorman and Alderman Travaglini. The motion passed unanimously.

Sign Permit Application #222-17: 7389 Watson Road, Vital Sign Company for Boost Mobile.

The Mayor reminded the Board that the Sign Permit Application had previously been noted as meeting City Code. She then called for a discussion. There being no discussion the Mayor requested a motion for approval. Alderwoman Gorman made the motion for approval, seconded by Alderman Scherer. The motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance – Bill No. 2905 Commercial Vehicles in the City of Shrewsbury**Second Reading, Consideration for Passage.**

The Mayor entertained a motion for the second reading of Bill No. 2905 on Commercial Vehicles in the City of Shrewsbury. Alderman Travaglini made the motion; this was seconded by Alderwoman Gorman. The motion carried. City Attorney Mike Daming read the ordinance by title only.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 383:020: COMMERCIAL VEHICLES PROHIBITED FROM USING CERTQAIN STREETS; OF CHAPTER 383: REGULATING THE KINDWS AND CLASSES OF TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS; OF TITLE III; TRAFFIC CODE; OF THE CITY OF SHREWSBURY, ISSOURI CODE, PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

The Mayor entertained a motion for consideration of passage of Bill No. 2905 on Commercial Vehicles on specific streets in the City of Shrewsbury. Alderman Travaglini made the motion; this was seconded by Alderwoman Gorman. The Mayor then called for a roll call. Alderman Kauffman, “aye,” Alderman Travaglini, “aye,” Alderman Kopff, “aye,” Alderman Steingruby, “aye,” Alderman Scherer, “aye,” Alderman Gorman, “aye.”

There being a majority of votes in favor, Mayor Buckley declared the motion passed and that Bill No. 2905 was adopted as Ordinance No. 2892.

The Mayor entertained a motion for the first reading of Bill No. 2908 Annual Renewal of the Lease of Shrewsbury City Center. Alderman Steingrubby made the motion; this was seconded by Alderman Scherer. The motion carried. City Attorney Mike Daming read the ordinance by title only.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ANNUAL RENEWAL OF THE LEASE DATED MARCH 1, 2008 BETWEEN THE CITY OF SHREWSBURY, MISSOURI IMPROVEMENT CORPORATION AND THE CITY OF SHREWSBURY, MISSOURI FOR THE TENANCY OF THE SHREWSBURY CITY CENTER BY THE CITY.

Second Reading

The Mayor entertained a motion for the second reading of Bill No. 2908 Annual Renewal of the Lease of Shrewsbury City Center. Alderman Steingrubby made the motion; this was seconded by Alderman Scherer. The motion carried. City Attorney Mike Daming read the ordinance by title only.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ANNUAL RENEWAL OF THE LEASE DATED MARCH 1, 2008 BETWEEN THE CITY OF SHREWSBURY, MISSOURI IMPROVEMENT CORPORATION AND THE CITY OF SHREWSBURY, MISSOURI FOR THE TENANCY OF THE SHREWSBURY CITY CENTER BY THE CITY.

Consideration for Passage

The Mayor entertained a motion for consideration of passage of Bill No. 2908 on the Annual Renewal of the Lease. Alderman Steingrubby made the motion; this was seconded by Alderwoman Gorman. The Mayor then called for a roll call. Alderman Kauffman, “aye,” Alderman Travaglini, “aye,” Alderman Kopff, “aye,” Alderman Steingrubby, “aye,” Alderman Scherer, “aye,” Alderman Gorman, “aye.”

There being a majority of votes in favor, Mayor Buckley declared the motion passed and that Bill No. 2908 was adopted as Ordinance No. 2895.
