Public Hearing to Consider the 2014 Shrewsbury Community Development Block Grant Allocation


Alderman Travaglini gaveled in the public hearing. No members of the public were present, but the "Public Hearing Handout" supplied to the City of Shrewsbury by the grant administrator as is required by HUD when considering the allocation and distribution of Community Development Block Grant funds was made available. Alderman Travaglini explained that the City was again eligible to receive up to \$20,000 in CDBG funds, which the City had previously allocated in the following manner: \$15,000 for the street repair projects in eligible locations and \$5,000 for the Home Improvement Program (HIP). Alderman Travaglini stated that the Board of Aldermen had decided to use the entirety of the 2014 funds for repairs to the eligible roadwork. Alderman Kauffmann stated that he felt the money should be split as in previous years.

Alderman Kauffmann then asked if there were any members of the public that wished to address the Board regarding the allocation and distribution of the 2014 CDBG funds. No members of the public addressed the board.

Adjourn

Alderman Kauffmann made a motion to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Alderman Kopff and passed unanimously.
