Resolution 2019-01

WHEREAS, the City of Brentwood has experienced a significant degree of frequent flooding in its municipality along the Manchester Road Corridor over the previous century; and

WHEREAS, said flooding has caused significant property damage and has reduced property values in the area; and

WHEREAS, Brentwood has developed an approach to remediate the flooding issue by the creation of a district development project entitled Brentwood Bound; and

WHEREAS, the City of Shrewsbury shares a common watershed with Brentwood, called the Deer Creek Watershed; and

WHEREAS, the Deer Creek Watershed directly affects the floodplain and floodway footprint located within the City of Shrewsbury; and

WHEREAS, the City of Shrewsbury's staff has reviewed the Brentwood Bound plan and found that the floodplain and floodway footprint located within the City of Shrewsbury would be diminished due to this project; and

WHEREAS, Shrewsbury's authorization and consent are required in order to allow the Federal Emergency Management Agency to update the NFIP floodplain maps located within, and adjacent to, the City of Shrewsbury.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SHREWSBURY, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City of Shrewsbury hereby expresses its support for the Brentwood Bound Project.

Section 2. The Board hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Overview and Concurrence Form, a copy of which is attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, along with any other documentation deemed necessary to reflect the support of the City described herein.
