STP Project Update – The Next Phase

Dear Residents & Business Owners,

Please note that the next phase of the STP project will begin next week. On Monday, the contractor, Spencer Contracting, will begin staging street repair equipment near the Weil Avenue railroad crossing. They will also do minor concrete work on Monday at the train tracks.

Then at 7:00 a.m., on Tuesday, June 27th, Weil Avenue will be closed to through traffic at the railroad crossing. The construction crews will begin milling the aging asphalt, starting at the railroad crossing. The milling will extend to the eastern city limits, next to the Shrewsbury Lanes bowling alley, and will extend across a portion of the Roofer's Mart access drive lane, across from the electric plant.

The closure of Weil Avenue will extend throughout Tuesday, June 27th and Wednesday, June 28th. The rear access point at Dierberg's/U.S. Post Office (leading to Weil Avenue) and the Jacobs Old Coal Road will also be closed during this time.

The detour route during this time period will include the following roadways: St. Vincent, Murdoch, Lansdowne, and the River Des Peres. Local traffic and deliveries will be able to access the various residential homes and businesses during most of this time frame. However, there may be periods during which traffic will be temporarily held for necessary work to be performed.

After the milling is completed, the next stage is asphalt replacement.

This next phase will be performed in concert with all government agencies, and includes the cooperation of the BNSF Railroad. Additionally, there will be flaggers present to guide traffic, as well as police present to assist.

Please avoid this area during this time period to ease congestion.
