

Annual Report Overview

In the year of 2007, total crimes went down 2.03% from 2006. In 2006 there were 197 Part 1 and Part 2 crimes reported. In 2007 there were 193 Part 1 and Part 2 crimes reported.

Calls for service decreased 21.31% from 2006. There were 13,205 calls for service in 2006 and 10,390 calls for service in 2007.

The Criminal Investigation Division had a clearance rate of 63% in 2007.

Reports written in 2007 increased 9.11% from 2006. In 2006, 911 police reports were written. In 2007, 994 police reports were written.

The total number of arrests in 2007 increased 20.06% from 2006. In 2006 there were 329 total arrests. In 2007 there were 395 arrests.

There were a total of 3,012 summons issued by the police department in the year of 2007.

Traffic accidents decreased 2.40% from 2006. In 2006, 208 traffic accident reports were written. In 2007, 203 accident reports were written.


Shrewsbury Police Department employees received a total of 1,441 hours of training in 2007.






Calls for Service

Reported Crimes











Accident Classification Type



Accidents by Time of Day




Accidents by Day of Week


Accident Report Locations

The Shrewsbury Police Department wrote 203 vehicle accident reports in 2007. Of the 203 reports written, 64.53% were on County or State Arterial Roadways. Of the remaining reports, 22.66% were on Private Property and 12.81% were on City Roadway. Over the past 5 years the average amount of accident reports written per year is 206. In 2007 there were 3 less reports written than the average.

Accident Reports





All officers qualified with their duty weapons twice this year. Once at the St. Louis County Police Department's range and once at the Webster Groves Police Department's range with Shrewsbury Police Department Instructors. The firearms training included duty weapons, off duty weapons and department shotguns.

All officers received the following in-service roll call training refreshers: use of force, department authorized weapons, standards of conduct, harassment in the work place, pursuit review, vehicle operation, discipline system, temporary holding, employee domestic violence. All officers also received Live Scan Fingerprinting and Consular Notification training.

Crisis Intervention Team

The Shrewsbury Police Department currently has twelve police officers trained and certified as Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) members. Three police officers attended the 40 hour training course at the St. Louis County & Municipal Police Academy in the year of 2007. The Crisis Intervention Team members receive in depth training on how to recognize and deal with those suffering from mental illness. The goal of the Crisis Intervention Team is to properly deal with and assist those who are mentally ill. The program is administered by the St. Louis County Police Department and the St. Louis County Circuit Courts has organized a mental health division as a jail diversion program. The mental health court was designed to assist offenders who have been officially diagnosed with a mental illness and have been charged with a crime as a result of their condition. The goal of the St. Louis County Mental Health Court is to provide offenders with resources to assist them effectively deal with their mental illness so they can live productive lives. The Shrewsbury Police Department joined the Crisis Intervention Team in 2005 and joined the St. Louis County Mental Health Court in 2006. The goal of the Shrewsbury Police Department is to get 100% of the patrol officers trained as CIT members and remain dedicated to the Crisis Intervention Team's efforts. We currently have 71% of the department CIT trained.
