

Annual Report Overview

In the year of 2008, total crimes went up 9.32% from 2007. In 2007 there were 193 Part 1 and Part 2 crimes reported. In 2008 there were 211 Part 1 and Part 2 crimes reported. In 2008 Part 1 crimes went up 3.3% and Part 2 crimes went up 19.44%.

Calls for service increased 25.71% from 2007. There were 10,390 calls for service in 2007 and 13,061 calls for service in 2008.

The Criminal Investigation Division had a clearance rate of 75% in 2008.

Reports written in 2008 decreased 4.63% from 2007. In 2007, 994 police reports were written. In 2008, 948 police reports were written.

The total number of arrests in 2008 decreased 5.06% from 2007. In 2007 there were 395 total arrests. In 2008 there were 375 arrests.

There were a total of 3,673 traffic summons issued by the police department in the year of 2008, which is an increase of 21.95% from 2007.

Traffic accidents increased 3.94% from 2007. In 2007, 203 traffic accident reports were written. In 2008, 211 accident reports were written.


Shrewsbury Police Department employees received a total of 1,454 hours of training in 2008.






Calls for Service

Reported Crimes











Accident Classification Type



Accidents by Time of Day




Accidents by Day of Week


Accident Report Locations

The Shrewsbury Police Department wrote 211 vehicle accident reports in 2008. Of the 211 reports written, 33.18% were on State Arterial Roadways and 45.50% were on County Arterial Roadways. Of the remaining reports, 14.22% were on Private Property and 7.10% were on City Roadway. Over the past 5 years the average amount of accident reports written per year is 205. In 2008 there were 3 more reports written than the average.



All officers qualified with their duty weapons twice during 2008. Both training / qualifications courses were conducted at the Webster Groves Police Department's range with Shrewsbury Police Department Firearms Instructors. This was due to the transition from the Glock Model 17 9mm to the Glock Model 22 .40 caliber. The firearms training included duty weapons, off duty weapons and department shotguns.

All officers received the following in-service roll call training refreshers: use of force, department authorized weapons, pursuit policy, vehicle operation, harassment & discrimination in the workplace, employee speech rights, internal affairs policy, prisoner booking and detention, grievance policy, body cavity searches, and all hazards plan.

All officers also received DNA evidence training, weapon of mass destruction training, REJIS recertification, CPR recertification, and BAC / DataMaster recertification

Crisis Intervention Team

The Shrewsbury Police Department currently has fifteen police officers trained and certified as Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) members. Three police officers attended the 40 hour training course at the St. Louis County & Municipal Police Academy in the year of 2008. The Crisis Intervention Team members receive in depth training on how to recognize and deal with those suffering from mental illness. The goal of the Crisis Intervention Team is to properly deal with and assist those who are mentally ill. The program is administered by the St. Louis County Police Department and the St. Louis County Circuit Courts has organized a Mental Health Division as a jail diversion program. The Mental Health Court was designed to assist offenders who have been officially diagnosed with a mental illness and have been charged with a crime as a result of their condition. The goal of the St. Louis County Mental Health Court is to provide offenders with resources to assist them effectively deal with their mental illness so they can live productive lives. The Shrewsbury Police Department joined the Crisis Intervention Team in 2005 and joined the St. Louis County Mental Health Court in 2006. The goal of the Shrewsbury Police Department is to get 100% of the patrol officers trained as CIT members and remain dedicated to the Crisis Intervention Team's efforts. We currently have 88% of the police department CIT trained.

In 2008 the Shrewsbury Police Department investigated a total of two Internal Affairs complaints. Of the two complaints, one was made by a citizen and one originated from within the police department. Both complaints were separate but involved the same employee.

Regarding the external complaint, a citizen alleged that an officer used overbearing conduct during a pedestrian check. There was no evidence to support the allegation and the complaint was unfounded.

Regarding the internal complaint, a supervisor was disciplined for exhibiting inappropriate behavior in front of subordinate officers. As result, the supervisor received the appropriate discipline, counseling and training.
